

GRIFFITH UNIVERSITY DOUBLES EBOOK USAGE WITH FLEXIBLE EBOOK SOLUTIONS

In 2017, Griffith University, a public research university in South East Queensland, Australia, started an evidence-based model, licensing four Springer Nature eBook collections including Biomedical & Life Sciences, Computer Science, Engineering, and Medicine. The institution decided to increase its content offering in August 2022, by licensing the Access & Select Smart EBA Option, an evidence-based eBook model that combines access with additional services, part of Springer Nature's Flexible eBook solutions.

With a range of plans to choose from, this eBook EBA option offers a large selection of content and the flexibility to license titles which have proved popular with users. Each year that the subscription is renewed, access grows, giving users access to an even greater volume of eBooks.

Why Access & Select?

Griffith University chose Access & Select Smart because it provides access to all subject collections for the copyright years of the contract year and three additional years on top. It also gives the university the option to use 100% of the value of the fee to license selected titles that have proven demand and includes the MyCopy print-on-demand eBook service. 

For more information on Springer Nature flexible eBook solutions contact a Licensing Manager Since Griffith University started licensing Springer Nature eBooks, usage has significantly increased from 149,792 to 797,173 chapter requests between 2017 and 2023 (see graph 1). The increased uptake of Springer Nature eBook content by the university's students and researchers encouraged Griffith University to expand its collaboration with Springer Nature and switch to the Access & Select Smart model. "We always knew that the quality of Springer eBooks would appeal to both undergraduates, postgraduates and researchers, so we assumed that usage would keep expanding."

How has Griffith University benefitted from its Access & Select license?

Even before the Covid 19 pandemic Griffith University already provided 70% of resources in electronic format, which has now increased to 99% across eight campuses and five libraries. In 2017 the institution started off with an evidence-based model including four eBook collections but in 2021 a survey showed that certain requirements from researchers were still not fulfilled.


Their strategy was to introduce an all-encompassing evidence-based acquisition solution containing quality eBooks. Gaps in the collection were filled through the Access & Select Smart model and Griffith University decided to combine it with the Springer Nature Reference Modules to support their cross-disciplinary research. "We now have a greater range of eBooks to choose from that is larger than the previous six subject areas, which suits the crossdisciplinary nature of the programs and courses provided across Griffith University," says Belinda Nicolson-Guest

Reference Module usage at Griffith University

The institution decided to license five Reference Modules: Physical & Materials Science; Medicine; Humanities & Social Sciences; Computer Science & Engineering, Biomedical & Life Sciences. The reason behind this decision was to fulfil previously unmet demand for reference resources which made a good business case, said Belinda Nicolson-Guest.

In 2023, the Humanities and Social Sciences Reference Module had the highest usage amongst students and researchers at Griffith University (see graph 2). According to Belinda Nicolson-Guest, Humanities and Social Sciences faculty and students use a broad range of online resources, especially reference works, so it is not surprising that reference modules have such a high usage. In addition, the university conducts a lot of cross-disciplinary research.

How is Griffith University encouraging usage of its eBook content across the university?

Since introducing Access & Select Smart in August 2022 the institution's usage per month has doubled (see graph 3). To encourage usage of eBooks the university promotes the content through posts on library and academic blogs and in addition, their discipline librarians promote quality eBooks within Academic Engagement Services (Learning & Teaching and Researcher Services).

Libraries at Griffith University have to present a business case for new content they would like to license, explains Belinda Nicolson-Guest. When the institution first started licensing the evidence-based acquisition model, they were concerned about the costs. The university executed surveys to establish researchers' needs and found a good return on investment with Springer Nature eBook content. The institution promotes Springer Nature content at their market days, where they inform students about Springer Nature eBook content. In addition, they organise webinars for students through their frontline services.

"Faculty and students are all time poor in the world of trimesters, you only hear from them if they have something to complain about and there have been no negative comments regarding Springer Nature eBooks, so the proof is in the pudding," says Belinda Nicolson-Guest
